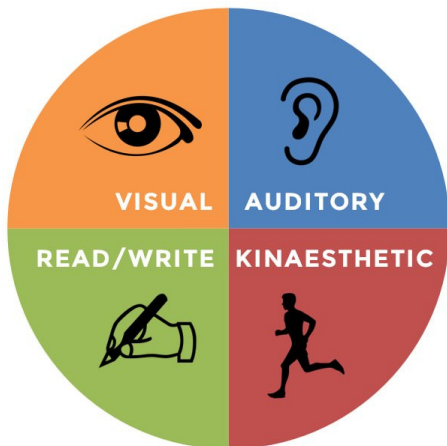




HOSTING STUDENTS WITH DIFFERENT LEARNING STYLES



Learning Styles

By understanding the style of learning your student responds to will help make their placement a success. There are four predominant styles you may encounter:

- **Visual** learners respond well to graphics and videos. The student may ask "Can you demonstrate that for me?"
- **Auditory** learners do best when listening to content. The student may ask "Can you explain that to me?"
- **Reading or writing** learners prefer text-based information and may write a lot of notes. The student may ask "Is there a manual or procedure I can read?"
- **Kinaesthetic** learners use their senses to learn via hands on experiences. The student may ask "Can I try that myself and you observe me?"
